 - \$180,000 for Salary Increases
 - \$150,000 for Young Farmer Programs
 - Newton County
 - Fannin County
- Need to continually involve and speak with legislators to promote additional funding for growth of our program
 - Usually 10-12 new positions per year
 - We are highly accountable for our funds
 - A growing program is a good thing and should be supported by our legislature

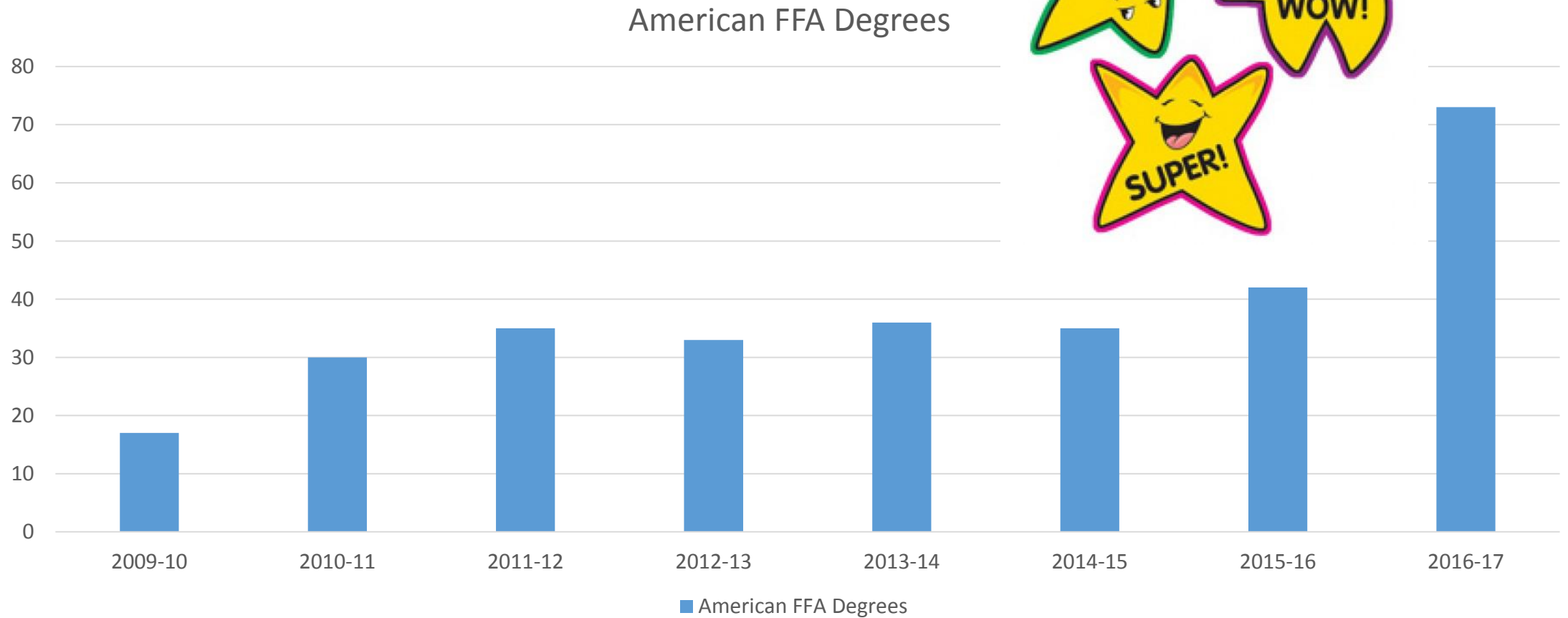

Georgia Junior National Livestock Show Changes for 2017-2018

Champions will not be harvested. (No change)

A committee has been formed to explore the possibilities and scheduling for a Champion Drive for all species for 2019. As it stands, there will be a Banquet for 2018.

The State Veterinarian's Office is expecting to release updated health regulations. Official ID will probably be required for all show animals.

- Sheep and Goats already require "Scrapie Tags". (No change expected)
- Hog already have to have official ID for testing. (No change expected)
- Cattle may be required to have official ID this year. (Pending)

MARKET HOGS:

Weight Limit Change for Showmanship:

Weight limits for market show are 220-280 pounds. Weight limits for Swine Showmanship will be 200-300lbs *as long as the participant does not have another gilt/barrow within the 220-280 weight limit.* If the participant has another gilt/barrow within current weight limits for the market show, the participant will be required to show that gilt/barrow in showmanship.
