

2022-2023 NATIONAL FFA SCHOLARSHIPS FACT SHEET

- 840 students from 43 states were awarded more than \$1.6 million in scholarships from 49 corporate sponsors, 41 endowed sponsors, 187 Ford dealer scholarship sponsors.
- 4,786 students successfully completed the application process, each with the potential of being considered for multiple scholarships.
- The application and acceptance processes are managed through an online portal, helping to reduce the organization's carbon footprint and allows for a more streamlined process for students to receive scholarships.
- Scholarships range in size from \$500 to \$10,000 and several are renewable for up to four years.
- FFA scholarships support vocational certification and specialized training programs.
- FFA scholarships support two-year or four-year degrees.
- FFA members are eligible to receive scholarships while they are graduating high school seniors. Former FFA members and FFA Alumni and Supporters can also receive funding during their undergraduate collegiate experience.
