1. All Georgia 4H and FFA members are eligible to show in the Winter Dairy Showcase. 2. All entries must be able to provide an accurate, up to date health certificate that has been issued by a licensed veterinarian.
3. Each heifer entered must have a clean, readable state ear tag in place. No entries will be accepted without an ear tag.
4. There is no limit on entries per exhibitor, however, each entry can only be shown by one exhibitor.
5. Cattle will show as commercial dairy heifers and will be divided into classes by weight. Depending on entries, a registered division may be added at the discretion of show management. To show in the registered division, proper registration paperwork from the breed association must be presented at check-in.
6. Showmanship classes will be divided by grade level. Depending on entries, divisions may be divided into heats.
7. All entries must weigh under the maximum of 850 pounds at the time of check-in to be considered eligible to show. Heifers will not be reweighed once they leave the scale.
8. An exhibitor will not be permitted to enter the show ring with another student's calf unless the calf belongs to an exhibitor with two entries in the same class.
9. The Top 5 Dairy Heifers will be selected in the final drive. Class premiums/payout will depend on the amount of entries received.
10. All entries must be postmarked by January 12, 2026. The entry fee is \$20.00 per heifer, and \$5.00 for showmanship. Late entries will be accepted, but the fees will increase to \$25.00 per heifer, and \$10 for showmanship beginning January 13, 2025.
