- Show is located at the Polk County CCA Agriculture Center behind Rockmart High School.
- Due to space limitations, entries will close at 75 head. Entries are limited to two animals per contestant. Show is limited to junior exhibitors in grades 4-12.
- Show is Saturday, December 2, 2023.
 - Check in 7am – 9am
 - Show starts at 10:00 a.m.
 - Show Order:
 - Showmanship (shown by grade--youngest to oldest – winners receive buckles!)
 - Steers (shown by weight)
 - Heifers-
 - British (shown by birthdate)
 - Continental (shown by birthdate)
 - Commercial (shown by weight)
 - *Show management reserves the right to adjust/break the number of classes as needed based on entries.*
- Steers and commercial heifers will be shown by weight (born after 1/1/2022)
 - Steers will show for Grand and Reserve.
- Registered heifers will be shown by age (born After 1/1/2022)
 - Heifers will show for Grand and Reserve in each Division.
 - Division Champions and Reserve Champions will show for Overall Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion.
- **This is a “blow and go” show. No fitting is allowed.**
- Exhibitors may have to tie to trailers if there are no spaces left in the barn
- Bring generators due to electrical shortage capacity
- An official health certificate is required by Georgia Department of Agriculture regulations must accompany steers and heifers. Health papers may be subject to be checked upon arrival.
- Premium money paid out according to availability of funds.
- Entry forms should be postmarked November 10, 2023. (Entries will NOT be accepted the day of the show.)
- Make entries payable to Polk County Young Farmers.
- Exhibitors and guests will be expected to follow social distancing guidelines. Please do not attend the show if you are exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms or have recently tested positive.
- Concessions will be available for snacks and drinks. There are also a variety of fast-food restaurants close to the showgrounds for other meal options.
