1. Any exhibitor under the age of 21 will be allowed to enter the show. Pre-club exhibitors must be able to exhibit his/her hog without the assistance of an adult or older exhibitor in the ring.
2. Entries will be limited to the first 150 head of swine entered. Once this number is reached, we will stop accepting entries for the show. If the entries have already been mailed, we will notify the exhibitor and return their entry to them.
3. Exhibitors who are housing pigs in the barn will be given a pen assignment. The pens are 5' X 5' and will be assigned on first-come, first-served basis as entry forms are received. Shavings will **NOT** be provided so please plan on bringing your own. No tack pens will be provided. Two pigs will be placed in each pen so prepare to bring a divider if it is needed.
4. Exhibitors may show off the trailer for a \$25 fee per trailer. Due to limited space around the facility, this option will be limited to 15 trailer spots, sold on a first come first serve basis. If you are not allotted a trailer spot then pens will be provided for you in the barn and your \$25 will be returned. If this occurs, you will be notified prior to the show date.
5. All entries must be accompanied by current health papers at the time of check-in.
6. All hogs must be tagged, and tag numbers must be included on the entry form.
7. All male hogs must be castrated and fully healed to compete in this jackpot.
8. The **weight limit** for this jackpot is **300 pounds**. Anything over 300 pounds will be disqualified.
9. Check-In will take place from **5:00 PM to 7:00 PM on Friday or 7:00 - 9:00 AM on Saturday**. At Check-in you will be required to give purebred registration papers and weigh your animals. The show will begin at 10:00 AM, or as soon as weight classes have been broken.
10. Showmanship will be broken into grade ranges after the entries have been received.
11. After pigs have been weighed and leave the scales, there will be no changes made. Any changes that need to be made must be made before leaving check-in.
12. Payout will be determined upon the number of entries. **Barrows and Gilts will show SEPARATELY** and we will recognize a Grand and Reserve Champion in both categories. If numbers are sufficient we may further divide entries into dark and light cross classifications.
13. The judge's decision is final in all classes.
14. Exhibitors are responsible for his or her own animal and must assume all associated risk.
15. Ware County BOE and Ware County High School, nor anyone or anybody associated with the show are liable for accidents, injuries, or theft.

PUREBRED MARKET HOG SHOW

- Four purebred market hog breeds will be recognized: Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, All Other Breeds.
- The original registration certificate must be presented at the time market hogs are checked into the show. No copies or duplications of the original registration certificate will be accepted. Registration certificate must be made out in the exhibitor's name only. Farm names will not be acceptable.
- All purebred animals will show in one class. If entries permit, there could be multiple classes that will then be broken by weight. The winner of this Division will be eligible to compete in the final drive for Grand and Reserve Champion.
