SHOW RULES & GUIDELINES

Please read all rules and guidelines! It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, parents, and advisors to understand the guidelines for the show and to ask questions if something is not understood. Please feel free to reach out to Benjamin Richardson by email at <u>brichardson@effingham.k12.ga.us</u> or by phone at 912-429-6974 if you have questions about the show!

- 1. Show and showmanship will only be for 4th through 12th grade.
- 2. <u>All</u> market steers and commercial heifers will be shown by weight and <u>all</u> registered heifers will be shown by birthdate and breed. Registered heifers will need registration papers in the exhibitor's name presented at the time of check-in.
- 3. All entries must have a form of identification (tattoo and/or tag number)
- 4. All animals presented for exhibition purposes shall be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate stating that these animals are from herds not under quarantine and are apparently free of all infectious, contagious, or communicable diseases.
- 5. Entries are open to 4-H and FFA Members. Each participating exhibitor should fill out a separate entry form (no family or group entry forms).
- 6. Each exhibitor will receive a complimentary t-shirt (sizes Adult Small to Adult 2XL) as a gift for entry, and extra t-shirts may be made available for sale during the show after the conclusion of check-in.
- 7. There is no limit to the number of cattle entries per exhibitor.
- 8. Show will be Jackpot style. Payouts will be the Top three in each class, showmanship winners, and grand and reserve champion steers and heifers.
- 9. All entries must be postmarked by January 2, 2024. A late fee of \$10 per animal will be required after this date and will be collected at or before check-in. THE LATE FEE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AND **NO REFUNDS** WILL BE GIVEN.
- 10. Show will be classified as a **blow-and-go show**. Fitting of the animal is to be done at the discretion of the exhibitor.
- 11. All animal projects will be shown at the owner's risk. Each exhibitor must assume responsibility in the case of injury.
- 12. Power is limited at Honey Ridge Agricenter. Generators are STRONGLY recommended. Exhibitors will be encouraged to show from the trailer, as inside the barn tie space is also limited and will be on a first come first serve basis.
