- 1. Show will be held at the Gilmer County Agriculture Education Center located at 1020 Clear Creek Road in Ellijay, Georgia 30536.
- 2. Commercial heifers must be born between March 1 and September 30, 2022 Max Weight- 850
- 3. Registered Show Classes- Registration Papers and Lease Agreements will be checked a. Fall Calf: 9/1/22 11/30/22

b. Summer Yearling: 6/1/22 - 8/31/22

c. Spring Yearling: 3/1/22 - 5/31/22

d. Winter Yearling: 12/1/21 - 2/28/22

e. Fall Yearling 9/1/21 - 11/30/21

- 4. Facility will be open Friday night until 7:00 PM. Call for later check-in
- 5. The Show is open to Georgia 4-H and FFA members.
- 6. All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed.
- 7. All Heifers must be ear tagged with state identification tags
- 8. **Weigh In:** After the Heifer leaves the scales there will be no additional weigh in without show official consent.
  - Weigh in begins Saturday, January 28th from 7:30 a.m. to 9 a.m. Show starts at 10:30 AM
- 9. Commercial Heifers will be weighed and divided into classes as equal in number as possible. (Number of classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show official's discretion).
- 10. **Showmanship**: Showmanship will be based on grade in school and will be divided as close to equal as possible based on the number of entries. Combined Showmanship Classes will be used for premiums paid. Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor. Start youngest to oldest show will begin at 10:30 a.m.
- 11. Exhibitors must show their own Heifer in class. If the exhibitor has more than one Heifer in a class, they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
- 12. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification. Any visible sick animal will be asked to leave the premises.
- 13. **Entry Fee**: The entry fee per animal is \$20. Late entries fee will be charged \$10.00 per animal/per exhibitor. Money will be used for prize money after expenses are removed. Amount of prize money is based on entries and is subject to change\*:
- 14. The Show Committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Show Committee are final.
