The show will begin at 11:00 a.m. with the showmanship competition starting with the oldest and working our way down. <u>ALL</u> <u>BLOCKING CHUTES MUST STAY OUTSIDE THE BARN.</u> (Other arrangements will be made if it is raining).

NOTE: Power at the Ag Center is very limited. Please bring generators if possible. Barn Space is also limited. Tie space in the barn is first come, first serve and the rest will have to tie to the trailer. Exhibitors who plan to stall in the barn need to bring shaving for tie down.

Rules and Regulations 29th Annual Moo Moo Classic September 11, 2021

CATTLE SHOW GUIDELINES

1. Exhibitor Age Requirements: 9 years old to 21 years old by Sept. 1 2021. Exhibitors who have graduated from high school will not be eligible to participate in showmanship.

2. Steers and Commercial Heifers will be shown by weight.

3. Registered heifers will be shown by age and will need registration papers in the exhibitor's name at check-in to be eligible for the registered heifers show. If not, they will be placed in the commercial heifer show and shown by weight. All Registered heifers will show together.

4. All entries must have a form of identification (tattoo and/or tag number).

5. All animals presented for exhibition purposes shall be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate stating that these animals are from herds not under quarantine and are apparently free of all infectious, contagious, or communicable diseases.

6. Entries are open to the world.

7. Check-in will be Saturday morning from 7-9 am.

8. There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor.

9. Show will be Jackpot style. Payout will be Top three in each class, Top three Steers, and Top three overall Heifers.

10.All entries must be postmarked by Sept. 3, 2021. A late fee of \$10 per head cash will be required after this date and will be collected at check-in. All entries should be mailed to Zachary Weaver, 110 Halcyondale Rd., Sylvania, GA 30467. THE LATE FEE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AND NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.

11.Showmanship will be broken up into groups. Cloverleaf (4^{th} and 5^{th} Grade), Intermediate (6^{th} – 8^{th} Grade), Junior (9^{th} and 10^{th} Grade) and Senior (11^{th} and 12^{th} Grade) Showmanship will start with the senior showmanship and work down.

12.Show will start at 11 am. Show order(Showmanship, Registered Heifers, Commercial Heifers, and Steers)

13.Show will not be classified as a fitting show or a blow and go show. Fitting of the animal is up to the exhibitor.

14. Classification of registered heifers is as follows:

Class I Junior heifer calves born January 1, 2021 and after

Class II Winter heifer calves born November 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020

Class III Fall heifer calves born September 1, 2020 through October 31, 2020

Class IV Summer heifers born July 1, 2020 through August 31, 2020

Class V Spring yearling born April 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020

Class VI Early Spring yearling born January 1, 2020 through March 31, 2020

Class VII Mature Winter Heifers born November 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019

Class VIII Mature Fall Heifers born September 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019.

15.Commercial heifers will be weighed but should conform to the ages listed above.

Directions

From I-16 and Statesboro:

Take US 301 North to Sylvania. Turn left onto Rocky Ford Road off of 301 bypass. This will be the first intersection on bypass after the traffic light at the south bypass. Ag Center will be 500 yards on the left.

From Waynesboro and points North:

Stay on 301 when highway GA 24 splits off and goes south. After the first traffic light turn right onto Rocky Ford Road at the first intersection south of the light at GA 21 and US 301. Ag Center is 500 yards on the left.

From Millen and points West:

At the light at GA 21 and US 301 turn right and then turn right again onto Rocky Ford Road at the first intersection south of the light. Ag Center will be 500 yards on left.

From Metter via Rocky Ford Road:

Ag Center will be on the right as you come into Sylvania. It will be about 300 yards past Screven County Correctional Institute.
