

## Georgia FFA Association 93<sup>rd</sup> State Convention Registration Information

## Chapter Registration Fee - \$150 per chapter

• Chapter registration fees are being used toward the cost of producing and conducting the entire virtual convention week, including the virtual convention website, virtual career show and sponsors meet & greet sessions, virtual workshops, and virtual convention sessions.

- There is no additional fee for those attending the in-person convention sessions on Saturday.
- Online Convention Registration will open by March 5 and will close on April 2.
- Convention Registration payments are due by April 15.

## Virtual Convention Week

• The virtual State Convention week will kickoff on Monday, April 19 with the opening of the virtual Career Show.

• The virtual Career Show will allow student opportunities to learn about (and from) industry professionals through online information, videos, and Sponsor/Vendor Meet & Greet opportunities. The virtual Career Show will remain open through mid-May, allowing students to access information about vendors even after the convention week.

• Student leadership workshops will be offered virtually on Tuesday, April 20, and Wednesday, April 21.

• Agricultural Education teachers are encouraged to use the virtual Career Show, Sponsor/Vendor Meet & Greets, student leadership workshops, Retiring Addresses, and virtual convention sessions as course curriculum during class time Monday through Friday of the virtual convention week.

## In-Person Convention Sessions (Saturday)

• On-stage recognition during the in-person sessions on Saturday will be to showcase the students and chapters who were recognized during the virtual sessions on Thursday and Friday. State Degree recipients, state finalists and state winners will have the opportunity to be recognized on stage and receive their award (plaque, certificate, etc....)

• Social distancing will take place for award recipients and all attendees of the in-person sessions.

• To maintain a safe and manageable audience, chapters are asked to reserve their in-person attendance to award winners who will be recognized on stage, advisors, award winner parents, and up to 3 additional students. Chapters who do not have students being recognized on stage are asked to reserve their attendance to one advisor and up to three students.

• Seating in the Arena of the Centreplex will be reserved by chapter and socially distanced.

• Both in-person sessions on Saturday will be streamed online for those who cannot attend.
