The total cost for registration is \$75.00 per student/advisor. You will not have to provide names at the time of registration. Names will be required during the month leading up to the conference. There is no cost for non-advisor chaperones. Since there is no cost for additional chaperones, we are requiring that if you bring three or more students of one gender, your chapter provides a chaperone that will stay in the cabin with your students. Our preference is that this chaperone will be a part of your school system/community. However, if you are unable to secure a chaperone, please

communicate with another teacher attending the conference to confirm an adult will be sleeping under the same roof as your students in case of an emergency. **Payment should be sent to the Georgia FFA office prior to the conference.** Students should plan to wear casual dress for the entirety of the conference. Additionally, we will host an FFA Quiz Contest during Discovery Conference. All students will have the opportunity to complete a written FFA quiz, with the top scorers answering oral questions for the chance to win a free FFA jacket or a \$75 SLC Scholarship.
